A weekend in the middle of June to celebrate contemporary art in Budapest
35 guided gallery tours, 5 routs, nearly 1000 attendees, 339 artworks, 51 artists



The third weekend in June was a great opportunity to experience what contemporary art is all about. As part of the Gallery Weekend Budapest (GWB), organized by the Association of Contemporary Galleries for the seventh time, we used contemporary art to break down our barriers and open up the side of ourselves that helps us to deepen our self-expression.

This year, Gallery Weekend Budapest once again offered a truly unique range of exhibitions and programs for art-loving and art-taught audiences. Over the 3-day event, nearly 1000 visitors viewed 339 works of art by 51 artists in 14 of Budapest's leading contemporary private galleries.

Meeting contemporary art in person and viewing the works of art brought us into a world we don't come into contact with in our everyday lives. Just as discovering each artist, viewing each work of art, visiting each exhibition, as a viewer, is a discovery of a previously unknown part of our ether, so too is each work a discovery for the artists.

"We are delighted to see that people's interest in contemporary art continues unabated. We are confident that the carefully curated exhibitions in the galleries have helped people to expand their world a little, which has been narrowing a little lately.
